Communication Corner

Affordable Connectivity Program

- The Affordable Connectivity Program (ACP) is an FCC benefit program that helps ensure that households can afford the broadband they need for work, school, healthcare and more.
- The benefit provides a discount of up to \$30 per month toward internet service for eligible households and up to \$75 per month for households on qualifying Tribal lands. Eligible households can also receive a one-time discount of up to \$100 to purchase a laptop, desktop computer, or tablet from participating providers if they contribute more than \$10 and less than \$50 toward the purchase price.
- The Affordable Connectivity Program is limited to one monthly service discount and one device discount per household.

FTTH Battery Backup Information

DID YOU KNOW? Hancock Telephone furnishes a backup battery to all FTTH (Fiber to the Home) customers with telephone service.

* If your ONT (Optical Network Terminal) Fiber Device in your home loses power, your telephone service will not work, including any 911, security, and/or medical monitoring that relies on our telephone service.*

How does the backup battery work?

- In the event of a power outage, the backup battery is designed to provide standby backup power to the ONT for an estimated 8 hours in idle mode when the battery is new.
- The battery is intended to enable users to make short emergency/urgent telephone calls on a <u>corded</u> phone, as cordless phones will not work. Hancock Telephone recommends that you maintain at least one corded telephone for power outages.
- Once the power is back on, your backup battery will begin recharging itself.
- Additional batteries can be purchased from Hancock Telephone Company, and can stack together to provide extra standby and talk time.
