## 📍 Streaming services

These include TV shows and movies (also called “content”) that are delivered to your TV, computer or mobile device through the Internet, WiFi, or using cellular data. This gives you much more flexibility in what content you can watch, and where you can watch it!

**On Demand** streaming services offer a library of video content that you can access and watch whenever you choose, for example, Netflix, Prime Video and Hulu (although Hulu also offers Live TV)

**Live TV** streaming services include are delivered over the internet, but function like traditional cable TV in that you can browse an on-screen guide, watch shows live and record shows to watch later.

## 📍 Other ways to watch



### On your PC or MAC

Most streaming services allow you to watch directly from your computer by visiting their website on your favorite web browser (like Chrome or Safari)



### On your mobile phone or tablet

Most streaming services offer an app that is compatible with both iOS and Android mobile devices (phones and tablets). These are

especially handy for downloading shows and movies to take on the go.



### On your smart TV

Most TVs today are smart TVs - meaning they easily connect to WiFi and have streaming and other apps built in. If your smart TV already has the streaming services you want to watch, there’s no need to add a streaming device! Just sign into your account and start watching.

### How to set up your streaming device

There might be some subtleties between streaming devices, but you'll find that most of them are incredibly easy to set up!

- 1 Plug the device into the HDMI port on your TV, then plug into a power source.
- 2 Connect the device to your WiFi network (Make sure you have your WiFi password handy!)
- 3 Log into your streaming accounts (you may have to download some apps first, but most streaming devices come pre-loaded with the most popular services like Netflix or Prime Video) and start watching.
